

Day Schools: Regional league tables

WHILE A SCHOOL'S RATINGS AND RANK IN THE NATIONAL league tables is important, for day schools in particular, regional league tables are arguably more important because competition tends to be more intensive between institutions in the neighbourhood than with schools far away. Moreover respondents who constitute the sample base for perceptual surveys tend to be more knowledgeable about schools in their own regions than about institutions further afield. Therefore it's pertinent to bear in mind that day schools tend to have parochial, rather than national reputations and that regional ratings and ranking are perhaps more accurate indicators of the quality of education dispensed by them. Consequently, the EW-C fore survey of India's most respected day schools also offers readers regional league tables.

Northern Region

RANKED INDIA'S PREMIER DAY SCHOOL FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE years and second in 2010, Delhi's **The Shri Ram School** continues to top the Northern Region league table. However this year there's been a reshuffle in the all-Delhi Top 5 list with **The Mother's International** ranked No. 4 in 2009, moving up to second position in the north zone, and **Springdales, Dhaula Kuan** from No. 4 to third. **DPS, R.K. Puram**, despite retaining its position as India's premier school on the parameter of academic reputation, has yielded ground (3 to 4) as has **Sanskriti School, Chanakyapuri** (2 to 4). Conversely, **Vasant Valley, Delhi** (8 to 5) has made it into the Top 5 followed by **Step by Step, Noida** (9 to 6) with the hitherto unranked **Shri Ram School, Aravali, Gurgaon** (estb. 2000) making a spectacular debut at the Top 10 table which also includes **Sardar Patel Vidyalaya, Delhi** (5 to 6), **Modern School, Delhi** (6 to 8), **Amity International, Noida** (7 to 9) and **DPS, Noida** (28 to 10).

The notable advances in the Top 20 of the Northern Region league table, in which 89 schools were sufficiently well-known for rating and ranking, include Springdales Public School, Pusa Road, Delhi which moved up from No. 41 in 2009 to 11 this year; DAV, Sector 14, Gurgaon (unranked to 14); Army Public School, Dhaula Kuan, Delhi (39 to 19). Several previously unranked new entrants into the north zone Top 50 list include St. Frances de Sales, Delhi (21); Air Force Golden Jubilee Institute, Delhi (23); Laxman Public, Delhi (28); DPS, Dwarka (31); DPS, Indirapuram, Ghaziabad (32); Manav Sthali, Rajender Nagar, Delhi (37); St. Joseph's Academy, Dehradun (41); Brightlands, Dehradun (42); Ahlcon Public, Delhi and Eicher School, Faridabad (both ranked 45); Amity, Gurgaon and Seth M.R. Jaipuria, Lucknow and the Heritage School, Lucknow (all three ranked No.50).

Among the Northern Region schools which yielded advantage in 2010, and which need to get their act together and/or pay attention to their public images are Modern School, Barakhamba Rd, Delhi (No. 6 to 8); Amity International, Noida (7 to 9); Modern School, Vasant Vihar (15 to 18); Carmel Convent, Chanakyapuri (13 to 22); St. Columba's, Delhi (17 to 27); Loreto Convent, Lucknow (20 to 28); Air Force Bal Bharati, Delhi (14 to 30); Birla Vidya



Niketana, Delhi (24 to 31); Ahlcon International (21 to 33); Sacred Heart Public, Chandigarh (10 to 38); St. Stephen's, Chandigarh (22 to 38); La Martiniere, Lucknow (25 to 41); Ryan International, Vasant Kunj, Delhi (23 to 46); Doon International, Dehradun (45 to 61); and City Montessori, Lucknow (27 to 68).

Western Region

THE NOTABLE FEATURE OF THIS YEAR'S WESTERN REGION day schools league table headed again by **Cathedral and John Connon, Mumbai** is a churn in the Top 5 list. **Campion, Mumbai** has overtaken **Bombay Scottish** to be ranked second and the Ahmedabad-based **Riverside School** unranked in the previous two years has made a spectacular entrance into the Top 5 shortlist followed by **Ryan International School, Goregaon, Mumbai** at No.6. The Top 10 list also includes **St. Mary's, Mazgaon, Mumbai** (up from No. 11); **St. Xavier's** (8), and **J.B. Petit** (10), all Mumbai-based institutions. At No.9 is the previously unranked Ahmedabad-based **Eklavya**. Indeed, except for the two Ahmedabad-based schools, the western region Top 10 table is crowded with Mumbai schools.

Further down the list, the most notable new entrants into the Top 20 list are the previously unranked Sulochana Devi Singhania School, Thane and Arya Vidya Mandir, Mumbai at No. 11 and 12 respectively. Other previously unranked schools which are ranked high in the 2010 league table are St. Xavier's Boys Academy, Marine Lines, Mumbai (19); Gopi Birla Public, Malabar Hill (20); Utpal Shanghvi, Mumbai (21); DPS, Vashi (22) and Fr. Agnel, Navi Mumbai (27). Indeed most of the schools ranked between 41-50 in the west zone league table this year were unranked previously. New inclusions explains why this year 64 schools are included in the Western Region league table as against only 38 in 2009. This is a socially welcome development. It indicates that either school managements in western India are making greater efforts to project their institutions, or that the public is becoming more interested in measuring and comparing schools' educational performance. Or both.

With so many new entrants into the 2010 Western Region day schools league table and some institutions debuting within the Top 10, inevitably some hitherto highly-ranked primary-secondaries in the region have lost rank. Among them: St. Mary's, Pune which dropped from 10 last year to 16 in 2010; Hiranandani Foundation, Powai (11 to 17); Villa Theresa High, Mumbai (12 to 24); Our Lady of Perpetual Succour (16 to 26); Maneckji Cooper, Mumbai (15 to 29); Navrachna, Vadodara (23 to 30); St. Vincent, Pune (17 to 31); DPS, Vadodara

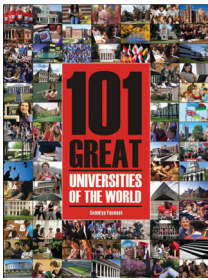
(22 to 32); St. Anthony High, Mumbai (20 to 37) and Children's Academy, Kandivli, Mumbai (34 to 54). Quite clearly inter-school competition for higher rank in the annual *EducationWorld* league tables of India's most respected schools is intensifying in western India, and that should be good news for parents and students.

Southern Region

IN THE SOUTHERN REGION AS WELL, ON THE REGIONAL TOP 10 table chaired by **Mallya Aditi International School, Bangalore** which has been transferred from the international to the day schools category (because it doesn't offer international curriculum in primary and/or middle school), this year, there's considerable replacement of name plates. New entrants are **National Public School, Indiranagar, Bangalore** which has leapfrogged from No. 15 in 2009 to second this year; **Vidya Niketan, Bangalore** (38 to 5); the related **Vidyashilp, Bangalore** (33 to 7), the hitherto unranked **Sloka School, Hyderabad** and **Pallikoodam School, Kottayam** (Kerala) debuting at No.6 and 9 respectively, and **Inventure Academy, Bangalore** (16 to 9) while **PSBB, Chennai** has moved higher up the table (8 to 3).



With the scandal hit Bishop Cotton Boys and Bishop Cotton Girls out of the Top 10 and ranked No. 11 and 15 in this year's peninsular league table, primary-secondaries which have moved into the Top 20 include Chirec Public, Hyderabad (22 to 14); National Public School, Koramangla, Bangalore (unranked to 15) and Kendriya Vidyalaya, IIT-Madras (34 to 21). Other southern schools which have risen in the public esteem are Air Force School, Hebbal, Bangalore (29 to 26) and National Academy for Learning, Bangalore (unranked to 28). Indeed several hitherto unranked, low-profile schools have debuted impressively to be ranked among the southern zone Top 50: St. George's Girls Grammar, Hyderabad (30); Shishugriha, Bangalore (35); PSBB Millennium, Chennai (38); Gear Foundation, Bangalore (40); and Venkateshwara International (41).

With so many schools debuting in this year's southern zone league table, some institutions had to concede rank to the newcomers. Apart from Bishop Cotton Boys and Girls which exited the Top 10 list, primary-secondaries ranked significantly lower in 2010 were Baldwin Boys, Bangalore (6 to 36); and Hyderabad's Little Flower (12 to 17), Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Jubilee Hills (11 to 18); St. Anne's (13 to 20), Jubilee Hills Public (20 to 31), and Johnson Grammar (27 to 38), making 2010 *annus horribilis* for this fast-track mini

metro. Moreover two hitherto highly regarded girls schools in Bangalore — Sacred Heart (32 to 46) and Sophia High (37 to 47) —also suffered a setback in this year's zonal league table. All of which goes to prove that reputations must not only be built, but maintained.

Eastern Region

ALTHOUGH KOLKATA'S LA MARTINIÈRE FOR BOYS AND GIRLS' schools have suffered a steep fall in the EW-C fore national day schools league table (from No. 3 to 16 and 7 to 18 respectively) as a consequence of the Rouvanjit Rawla suicide controversy, on its own turf in eastern India, the shadow of the tragedy has hardly dented the reputation of these two more than a century-old primary-secondaries. Though they have conceded top rank to **St. Xavier's Collegiate School, La Mart Boys** is ranked second and **La Mart Girls** No. 4 on the eastern regional table. Among the new invitees at the Eastern Region Top 10 table are **St. James, Kolkata** (13 to 3); **Sacred Heart Convent, Jamshedpur** (12 to 7); **Ashok Hall Girls** (20 to 8); and **St. Michael, Patna** (22 to 9), Bihar's No.1 primary-secondary.

Moreover several previously unranked schools have debuted: **DPS, Ruby Park** (12); **Assam Rifles, Shillong** (17); **DPS, Patna** (18) and **Heritage School, Kolkata** (19).
